## ORDINANCE No. 188398

Revise residential solid waste and recycling collection rates and charges, effective July 1, 2017 (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 17.102)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 164701, passed October 2, 1991, granted residential solid waste, recycling and yard debris collection franchises in the City of Portland as a way to introduce services, and implement standards and rates to encourage increased recovery of recyclable material from the waste stream.
- 2. Ordinance No. 185830, passed December 19, 2012, renewed the residential franchise system for a ten-year term.
- 3. As specified by Section 8 of the residential collection franchise agreement, the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability Solid Waste and Recycling Program conducted an annual rate review during the spring of 2017 to evaluate the cost of providing required service, based on actual data on costs, and management operations.
- 4. The rate review analysis for residential garbage, recycling and composting service shows that most rates will increase less than one percent due to higher costs for fuel and labor.
- 5. Staff for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability recommends that the Council approve the proposed amendments to the residential rate schedule, as set forth in Exhibit A to this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. City Code Chapter 17.102 shall be amended by deleting the existing Figure 6, *Residential Solid Waste and Recycling Rates*, and replacing it with the new Figure 6 in Exhibit A.
- b. The rates identified in Exhibit A shall be effective on and after July 1, 2017.
