ORDINANCE No.

Approve Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant Product Guidelines (Ordinance; amend Code Section 30.01.090)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In the 16/17 Adopted Budget, Portland City Council approved General Fund resources for the Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) to develop a Rental Rehabilitation Program, with allocated budget to be focused in East Portland.
- 2. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) Rental Rehabilitation Program is intended to prevent displacement of low-income families living in privately owned rental properties by providing City subsidies up to \$25,000 per unit to address habitability and property maintenance issues as described in Attachment A.
- 3. Owners of properties enrolled in the Rental Rehabilitation Program will receive a Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant that will be forgiven after 10 years if the full conditions of the grant have been met, including ongoing rental affordability for households under 60% of Area Median Income.
- 4. City Code Section 30.01.090 currently requires any project receiving City subsidies for the purpose of creating or preserving affordable rental housing to be subject to a minimum of 60-year affordability contract requirements. PHB desires to amend Subsection 30.01.090 to include 10-year affordability requirements for properties receiving a Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant from PHB.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant Product Guidelines are approved in accordance with the attached Exhibit B.

- b. Subsection 30.01.090 A. City Subsidy Projects Long-Term Affordability Requirements is amended as follows:
 - A. City Subsidy Projects that in the future request and receive a City Subsidy from PDC, PHB or other City bureau or agency for the purpose of creating or preserving rental housing affordable to households below 80 percent of MFI, will be subject to a minimum of 60-year affordability contract requirements developed by PHB consistent with the implementing charge in Subsection 30.01.090 B. Notwithstanding the foregoing, City Subsidy Projects that receive a Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant will be subject to a minimum of 10 year affordability contract requirement in accordance with the Rental Rehabilitation Conditional Grant Product Guidelines.
