Good Morning Mayor Wheeler, Commissioner Eudlay, Fritz, Hardesty:

For many years the City of Portland promised its SE residents that a park and recreational facilities would be made available to them at the old Washington High School site. Mr. Mayor you may recall us bringing this issue before you in the first meeting of your first term. To date all that we have is that promise and we are concerned that threats of Prosper Portland Investors may dash even that promise. I would ask the City Council to pass a Resolution stating their intent to retain PP&R's 4.5 acres open field located at SE Stark Street and SE 12th Avenue <u>for recreational use in the future and not sell or develop it for non-public use purposes.</u>

Roughly six years ago, standing outside Council Chambers, Commissioner Nick Fish told me there was nothing he could do to fund the <u>inner-southeast recreation center</u> until after the Fix-Our-Parks Bond Expired 2020. At the time of his passing -- he was leading discussion on how to provide stable funding for parks deferred maintenance and resources to close the services gaps providing new parks in neighborhoods where needed. As the RIP density in this city increases so does the need for open space and recreation facilities. Children have to have a place to play, to learn to swim and just be children. Parents need a place that is safe to take their children and recreate with them. Let's retain PP&R promise and possibilities by expressing intent to save the old Washington High School 4.5 acres open field for future generations in a RESOLUTION. I'm told today's City Budget is Four Billion. The \$100 million proposed innersoutheast Recreation Center's construction cost 5%.

I'm reminded of when attending the Mayor's annual budget review, Martha Pellegrino, Office of Governmental Relations stated her budget was like a flea on an elephant's tail. Like the \$100 million proposed inner-southeast Recreation Center's construction cost 5%.

Here is to a peaceful and prosperous 2020 for Portlanders.
