I. JURISDICTION

1. This Administrative Order on Consent ("Consent Order") is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the President of the United States by Section 122(g)(4) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(4), to reach settlements in actions under Sections 106 or 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 or 9607. The authority vested in the President has been delegated to the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") by Executive Order 12580, 52 Fed. Reg. 2923 (Jan. 29, 1987), and further delegated to the Regional Administrators of the EPA by EPA Delegation No. 14-14-E (issued Sept. 13, 1987, amended by memorandum June 17, 1988) and further delegated to the Assistant Regional Administrator for Ecosystems Protection and Remediation for Region VIII by EPA Delegation No. 14-14-E.

2. Each Respondent agrees to undertake all actions required by the terms and conditions of this Consent Order. Each Respondent further consents to and agrees not to contest EPA's jurisdiction to issue this Consent Order or to implement or enforce its terms.

3. EPA and Respondents agree that the actions undertaken by Respondents in accordance with this Consent Order do not constitute an admission of any liability by any Respondent. Respondents do not admit, and retain the right to controvert in any subsequent proceedings other than proceedings to implement or enforce this Consent Order, the validity of the Statement of Facts or Determinations contained in Sections IV and V, respectively, of this Consent Order.

II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

4. By entering into this Consent Order, the mutual objectives of the Parties are:

a. to reach a final settlement among the Parties with respect to the Site pursuant to Section 122(g) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g), that allows Respondents, subject to the terms specified in Section XI of this Consent Order, to make a cash payment, including a premium, to resolve their alleged civil liability under Sections 106 and 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 and 9607, for injunctive relief with regard to the Site and for response costs incurred and to be incurred at or in connection with the Site, thereby reducing litigation relating to the Site;

b. to simplify any remaining administrative and judicial enforcement activities concerning the Site by eliminating a substantial number of potentially responsible parties from further involvement at the Site; and,

c. subject to the terms specified in Section XI of this Consent Order, to obtain settlement with Respondents for their fair share of response costs incurred and to be incurred

at or in connection with the Site by the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund, and by private parties, to provide for full and complete contribution protection for Respondents with regard to the Site pursuant to Sections 113(f)(2) and 122(g)(5) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613(f)(2) and 9622(g)(5).

III. DEFINITIONS

5. Unless otherwise expressly provided herein, terms used in this Consent Order that are defined in CERCLA or in regulations promulgated under CERCLA shall have the meaning assigned to them in the statute or regulations. Whenever the terms listed below are used in this Consent Order or in the appendices attached hereto, the following definitions shall apply:

a. "CERCLA" shall mean the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 9601, et seq.;

b. "Consent Order" shall mean this Administrative Order on Consent and all appendices attached hereto. In the event of conflict between this Consent Order and any appendix, the Consent Order shall control;

c. "Day" shall mean a calendar day. In computing any period of time under this Consent Order, where the last day would fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or federal holiday, the period shall run until the close of business of the next working day;

d. "EPA" shall mean the United States Environmental Protection Agency and any successor departments, agencies or instrumentalities;

e. "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund" shall mean the Hazardous Substance Superfund established by the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 9507;

f. "Interest" shall mean interest at the current rate specified for interest on investments of the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund established by 26 U.S.C. § 9507, compounded annually on October 1 of each year, in accordance with 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a);

g. "Paragraph" shall mean a portion of this Consent Order identified by an Arabic numeral;

h. "Parties" shall mean EPA and the Respondents;

i. "Respondents" shall mean those persons, corporations, or other entities listed in Appendix A;

j. "Response costs" shall mean all costs of "response" as that term is defined by Section 101(25) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(25);

k. "Section" shall mean a portion of this Consent Order identified by a roman numeral;

l. "Site" shall mean the Chemical Handling Corporation Site, encompassing approximately 5 acres, located at 11811 Upham Street in Jefferson County, Colorado, as depicted on the map attached as Appendix B, and designated by the following property description:

A tract of land situated in the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 2 South, Range 69 West.

Commencing at a point on the East line of said NW1/4 of the NE1/4, which is 1438.74 feet North of the South line of the NE1/4 of Section 2, said point being on the North boundary line of Broomfield Industrial Park Filing No. 1;

thence Westerly and parallel with the said South line of the NE1/4, a distance of 498.00 feet to the Westerly right-of-way line of Upham Street and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;
thence Westerly and parallel with the said South line of the NE1/4, a distance of 452.09 feet, more or less, to the Easterly right-of-way of the Colorado and Southern railroad;

thence Northwesterly along said railroad right-of-way a distance of 290.38 feet, more or less, to a point which is 940.00 feet South of the North line of the NW1/4 of the NE1/4 of said Section 2;

thence Easterly and parallel with said North line, a distance of 539.03 feet, more or less, to the Westerly right-of-way line of Upham Street;

thence South along said Westerly right-of-way line, a distance of 192.27 feet, more or less, to a point of curvature;

thence continuing along said right-of-way, along the arc of a curve to the left 88.35 feet, having a radius of 45.00 feet, a central angle of 112°29'41" and a chord length of 74.83 feet;

thence continuing along said Westerly right-of-way, South 7.59 feet, more or less, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

m. "United States" shall mean the United States of America, including its departments, agencies and instrumentalities.

IV. STATEMENT OF FACTS

6. The Chemical Handling Corporation (CHC) operated at the Site as a solvent recycler and fuel blender from early 1988 until February, 1992. The fuel-blending operations combined hazardous wastes from various generators into a hazardous-waste fuel which was used in industrial furnaces and cement kilns. On February 7, 1992, the West Adams County Fire District (WACFD) issued CHC an Imminent Hazard Order requiring compliance within 72 hours. Subsequent to the issuance of this order, CHC entered into a stipulation to cease operation with the WACFD. CHC thereafter abandoned the Site and never resumed operations. On March 3, 1992, the WACFD issued Chemical Handling Corporation a notice of unsafe building declaring the main building at the Site to be a public nuisance. The Site is not included on the National Priorities List.

7. Hazardous substances within the definition of Section 101(14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(14), have been or are threatened to be released at or from the Site.

8. As a result of the release or threatened release of hazardous substances, EPA has undertaken response actions at or in connection with the Site under Section 104 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9604. EPA commenced a removal action at the Site on March 21, 1992. During the course of the removal action, EPA disposed of tens of thousands of gallons of hazardous substances contained in more than 2,000 55-gallon drums, numerous aboveground tanks and other containers. Soil and groundwater investigations were also conducted and it was determined that no significant levels of contamination had migrated offsite. The removal action has been completed and no further response action is planned.

9. In performing these response actions, EPA has incurred and will continue to incur response costs at or in connection with the Site. Costs incurred with respect to the Site as of December 31, 1995, were approximately \$2,574,205.07. To date, a very small portion of these response costs have been recovered

10. Information currently known to EPA indicates that each Respondent arranged for disposal or treatment, or arranged with a transporter for transport for disposal or treatment, of a hazardous substance owned or possessed by such Respondent at the Site.

11. Information currently known to EPA indicates that the amount of hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent does not exceed .7% of the hazardous substances sent to the Site for disposal, and the hazardous substances contributed by each Respondent to the Site are not significantly more toxic or of significantly greater hazardous effect than other hazardous substances at the Site. Attachment C lists the volume of the hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent.

12. EPA estimates that the total response costs incurred and to be incurred at or in connection with the Site by the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund and by private parties is between \$2,574,205.07 and \$2,625,000.00. The payment required to be made by each Respondent pursuant to this Consent Order is a minor portion of this total amount.

V. DETERMINATIONS

13. Based upon the Statement of Facts set forth above and on the administrative record for this Site, EPA has determined that:

- a. The Chemical Handling Corporation site is a "facility" as that term is defined in Section 101(9) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(9);
- b. Each Respondent is a "person" as that term is defined in Section 101(21) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(21);
- c. Each Respondent is a "potentially responsible party" within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1);
- d. There has been an actual or threatened "release" of a "hazardous substance" from the Site as those terms are defined in Section 101(22) and (14) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9601(22) and (14);
- e. As a result of the actual or threatened "release," EPA has incurred response costs;
- f. Prompt settlement with each Respondent is practicable and in the public interest within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1);
- g. As to each Respondent, this Consent Order involves only a minor portion of the response costs at the Site within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1); and,
- h. The amount of hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent and the toxic or other hazardous effects of the hazardous substances contributed to the Site by each Respondent are minimal in comparison to other hazardous substances at the Site within the meaning of Section 122(g)(1)(A) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(1)(A).

VI. ORDER

14. Based upon the administrative record for the Site and the Statement of Facts and Determinations set forth above, and in consideration of the promises and covenants set forth herein, the following is hereby AGREED TO AND ORDERED:

VII. PAYMENT

15. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Consent Order, each Respondent shall pay to the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund the amount set forth in Appendix C to this Consent Order.

16. Each Respondent's payment includes an amount for:

- a. past response costs incurred at or in connection with the Site;
- b. projected future response costs to be incurred at or in connection with the Site; and,
- c. a premium to cover the risks and uncertainties associated with this settlement, including but not limited to, the risk that total response costs incurred or to be incurred at or in connection with the Site by the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund, or by any private party, will exceed the estimated total response costs upon which Respondents' payments are based.

17. Each payment shall be made by certified or cashier's check made payable to "EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund." Each check shall reference the name and address of the party making payment, the Site name, the EPA Region and Site ID Number (08S5), and the EPA docket number for this action (CERCLA-VIII-96-09), and shall be sent to:

VIII. FAILURE TO MAKE PAYMENT

18. If any Respondent fails to pay the amount required within the time required by Paragraph 15, that Respondent shall pay Interest on the unpaid balance. In addition, if any Respondent fails to make full payment as required by Paragraph 15, the United States may, in

addition to any other available remedies or sanctions, bring an action against that Respondent seeking injunctive relief to compel payment and/or seeking civil penalties under Section 122(l) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(l), for failure to make timely payment.

IX. CERTIFICATION OF RESPONDENT

19. By signing this Consent Order, each Respondent certifies, individually, that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, it has:

a. conducted a thorough, comprehensive, good faith search for documents, and has fully and accurately disclosed to EPA, all information currently in its possession, or in the possession of its officers, directors, employees, contractors or agents, which relates in any way to the ownership, operation, or control of the Site, or to the ownership, possession, generation, treatment, transportation, storage or disposal of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant at or in connection with the Site;

b. not altered, mutilated, discarded, destroyed or otherwise disposed of any records, documents, or other information relating to its potential liability regarding the Site after notification of potential liability or the filing of a suit against it regarding the Site; and,

c. fully complied with any and all EPA requests for information regarding the Site pursuant to Sections 104(e) and 122(e) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9604(e) and 9622(e).

X. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY UNITED STATES

20. In consideration of the payments that will be made by Respondents under the terms of this Consent Order, and except as specifically provided in Section XI (Reservations of Rights by United States), the United States covenants not to sue or take administrative action against any of the Respondents pursuant to Sections 106 or 107 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606 or 9607, and Section 7003 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. § 6973, relating to the Site. This covenant not to sue shall take effect for each Respondent upon receipt by EPA of that Respondent's payment as required by Section VII. With respect to each Respondent, individually, this covenant not to sue is conditioned upon:

a) the satisfactory performance by Respondent of all obligations under this Consent Order; and,

b) the veracity of the information provided to EPA by Respondent relating to Respondent's involvement with the Site. This covenant not to sue extends only to Respondents and does not extend to any other person.

XI. RESERVATIONS OF RIGHTS BY UNITED STATES

21. The United States reserves all rights against Respondents with respect to all matters not expressly included within the United States' Covenant Not to Sue in Paragraph 20. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Consent Order, the United States reserves all rights against Respondents with respect to:

- a. criminal liability;
- b. liability for damages for injury to, destruction of, or loss of natural resources, and for the costs of any natural resource damage assessments; or
- c. liability based upon the ownership or operation of the Site or any activity with respect to a hazardous substance or a solid waste at or in connection with the Site after signature of this Consent Order by Respondents.

22. Notwithstanding any other provision in this Consent Order, the United States reserves, and this Consent Order is without prejudice to, the right to institute judicial or administrative proceedings against any individual Respondent seeking to compel that Respondent to perform response actions relating to the Site, and/or to reimburse the United States for additional costs of response, if information not contained in EPA's administrative record file as of the effective date of this Consent Order is discovered which indicates that such Respondent contributed hazardous substances to the Site in an amount greater than .7% of the hazardous substances sent to the Site, or which indicates that such Respondent contributed hazardous substances which are significantly more toxic or are of significantly greater hazardous effect than other hazardous substances at the Site.

XII. COVENANT NOT TO SUE BY RESPONDENTS

23. Respondents covenant not to sue and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against the United States or its contractors or employees with respect to the Site or this Consent Order including, but not limited to:

- a. any direct or indirect claim for reimbursement from the EPA Hazardous Substance Superfund based on Sections 106(b)(2), 107, 111, 112, or 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9606(b)(2), 9607, 9611, 9612, or 9613, or any other provision of law;
- b. any claims arising out of response activities at the Site; and,
- c. any claim against the United States pursuant to Sections 107 and 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613, relating to the Site.

24. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be deemed to constitute preauthorization or approval of a claim within the meaning of Section 111 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9611, or 40 C.F.R. 300.700(d).

25. Respondents covenant not to sue and agree not to assert any claims or causes of action against each other with regard to the Site pursuant to Sections 107 and 113 of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9607 and 9613.

XIII. EFFECT OF SETTLEMENT/CONTRIBUTION PROTECTION

26. Nothing in this Consent Order shall be construed to create any rights in, or grant any cause of action to, any person not a Party to this Consent Order. The United States and Respondents each reserve any and all rights (including, but not limited to, any right to contribution), defenses, claims, demands, and causes of action which each Party may have with respect to any matter, transaction, or occurrence relating in any way to the Site against any person not a Party hereto.

27. In any subsequent administrative or judicial proceeding initiated by the United States for injunctive relief, recovery of response costs, or other relief relating to the Site, Respondents shall not assert, and may not maintain, any defense or claim based upon the principles of waiver, *res judicata*, collateral estoppel, issue preclusion, claim-splitting, or other defenses based upon any contention that the claims raised in the subsequent proceeding were or should have been brought in the instant action; provided, however, that nothing in this Paragraph affects the enforceability of the covenant not to sue included in Paragraph 20.

28. The Parties agree that each Respondent is entitled, as of the effective date of this Consent Order, to such protection from contribution actions or claims as is provided by Sections 113(f)(2) and 122(g)(5) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9613(f)(2) and 9622(g)(5), for "matters addressed" in this Consent Order. The "matters addressed" in this Consent Order are all response actions taken by the United States and by private parties, and all response costs incurred and to be incurred by the United States and by private parties, at or in connection with the Site. Matters addressed does not include those response actions and those response costs for which liability is reserved in Section XI.

XIV. PARTIES BOUND

29. This Consent Order shall apply to and be binding upon EPA and upon Respondents and their heirs, successors and assigns. Any change in ownership or corporate or other legal status of a Respondent, including, but not limited to, any transfer of assets or real or personal property, shall in no way alter such Respondent's responsibilities under this Consent Order. Each signatory for a Respondent to this Consent Order certifies that he or she is fully authorized to enter into the terms and conditions of this Consent Order and to execute and bind legally the party represented by him or her.

XV. INTEGRATION/APPENDICES

30. This Consent Order and its appendices constitute the final, complete and exclusive agreement and understanding among the Parties with respect to the settlement embodied in this Consent Order. The Parties acknowledge that there are no representations, agreements or understandings relating to the settlement other than those expressly contained in this Consent Order. The following appendices are attached to and incorporated into this Consent Order:

"Appendix A" is the list of Respondents.

"Appendix B" is the map of the Site.

"Appendix C" is the volumetric ranking and settlement amounts.

XVI. PUBLIC COMMENT

31. This Consent Order shall be subject to a public comment period of not less than 30 days pursuant to Section 122(i) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i). In accordance with Section 122(i)(3) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(i)(3), EPA may withdraw or withhold its consent to this Consent Order if comments received disclose facts or considerations which indicate that this Consent Order is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate. Additionally, EPA may choose to make this Consent Order effective as to some Respondents and not as to others if comments or information is received before the Consent Order's effective date which indicate this Consent Order is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate as to one or more of the Respondents, but not as to all.

XVII. ATTORNEY GENERAL APPROVAL

32. The Attorney General or her designee has approved the settlement embodied in this Consent Order in accordance with Section 122(g)(4) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9622(g)(4).

XVIII. EFFECTIVE DATE

33. The effective date of this Consent Order shall be the date upon which EPA issues written notice to Respondents that the public comment period, pursuant to Section XVI, Paragraph 31 of this Consent Order, has closed and that comments received, if any, do not require modification of, or EPA withdrawal from, this Consent Order.

XIX. COUNTERPARTS

34. This Consent Order may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered to EPA shall be deemed to be an original, but such counterparts shall together constitute one and the same document.






