

**AMENDED AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES**

This amended agreement for services (AGREEMENT) is between the City of Portland (CITY) and Columbia Analytical Services (CONTRACTOR).

**RECITAL**

On February 2, 1993 the CITY entered into AGREEMENT No. 28583 with the CONTRACTOR to provide certain laboratory services not available from the City's Water Pollution Control Laboratory.

**AMENDED AGREEMENT**

Contract No. 28583 shall be amended as follows. All other conditions of the contract shall remain unchanged.

**1. Compensation**

The payment for work performed shall be in accordance with the price schedule submitted during consult selection (see Attachment 1). The total payment to the CONTRACTOR for the work was not to exceed \$90,000. However, the total number of necessary analyses has been, to date, several times higher than anticipated. Several remediation projects have occurred that were not originated budgeted for and more indepth organic analysis have been required than were originally planned. In addition a number of laboratory analyses that were planned to be done in house had to be sent to the CONTRACTOR because of equipment failure. The CITY shall add to the compensation, under this amended agreement, an additional \$40,000 so that the total compensation will be no more than \$130,000 (one hundred thirty thousand dollars).

# ORDINANCE No. 167565

- \* Authorize an amendment to agreement with Columbia Analytical Services to increase it by \$40,000 to cover additional services requested by the City (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 28583)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1: The City finds:

1. The City entered into an agreement for professional services with Columbia Analytical Services under Agreement No. 28583.
2. The additional services requested by the City were not included in the original agreement. The additional services are needed to fulfill the City's NPDES permit obligations.
3. Funds are available in the FY 1993-94 Bureau of Environmental Services budget to pay the additional costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Auditor are authorized to amend Agreement No. 28583 to increase it by \$40,000.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the FY 93/94 budget of the Bureau of Environmental Services, Center Code 14513021, Expenditure Code 521000, when demand is presented and properly approved.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in enactment of this ordinance will delay reimbursements to the contractor; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
