

**ORDINANCE NO. 164949**

\* Adopt the State of Oregon, 1991 Edition, Plumbing Specialty Code.  
(Ordinance; amend Code Section 25.01.020)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That pursuant to ORS 455.150, the City administers the provisions of the State of Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code and adopts this code by reference into the Code of the City of Portland.
2. That the current code referenced is the 1989 edition, however on January 1, 1991, the 1991 edition is effective throughout the State of Oregon.
3. That ORS 455.040 requires that the State Building Code, of which the Plumbing Specialty Code is a part, be uniform throughout the State of Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The first two paragraphs of Section 25.01.020, Scope - Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code, of Title 25, Plumbing Regulations, are hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

**25.01.020 Scope - Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code.**

This title shall apply to all plumbing done within the City, except sewer facilities installed by the City Engineer through contract or by City work force in any public place or right-of-way for the disposal of sanitary or storm drainage; and water supply facilities installed by the Water Engineer through contract or City work force in any public place or right-of-way for supplying the water service.

The provisions of the Uniform Plumbing Code, [1988] 1991 edition, including the appendix, published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, as amended by the State of Oregon, Building Codes Agency, and known as the [1990] 1992 edition of the Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code, three copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Auditor, hereby are adopted by reference and such provision shall apply within the City except as to matters specifically covered by the provisions set forth in this Title, and in all cases where specific provision of this Title applies, such provision shall control notwithstanding any contrary provisions of said Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code.

- b. Section 25.01.030 is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

**25.01.030 One and Two Family Code.** The provisions of the State of Oregon, [1986] 1989 Edition, One and Two Family Dwelling Specialty Code, as published by the Council of American Building Officials and amended by the [Department of Commerce,] Building Codes [Division] Agency, is hereby adopted by reference. The One and Two Family Code is on file in the City Auditor's Office.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the State of Oregon, 1992 Edition, Plumbing Specialty Code becomes effective in Oregon on January 1, 1992, this amendment will become effective January 1, 1992.

Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists, and in order to avoid any misunderstanding as to the application of the Plumbing Specialty Code within the City of Portland, the City's Plumbing Regulations must be amended without undue delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 1992.
