This is a renewal to Multnomah County Contract referenced above effective July 1, 2009 between Multnomah County District Attorney's Office, hereinafter referred to as County, and City Of Portland, though it is Portland Police Bureau, hereinafter referred to as Contractor.

The parties agree:

- 1. The following changes are made to Contract No. 4600005419 Amendment 4:
 - a. Extend contract period 07/01/09 06/30/10; add dollar in the amount of \$29,139.08.
 - b. The District Attorney's Office shall pay Portland Police Bureau quarterly. Portland Police Bureau shall submit invoices on a quarterly basis as follows:

- 2. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain the same.
