## ORDINANCE No. 183508

\*Grant sewer easement under Ivon Street Park to the adjacent property owner. (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City owns real property at 2533 SE 47<sup>th</sup> (Park), which is informally referred to as 1. Ivon Street Park, that has been assigned to the Bureau of Parks and Recreation (Parks).
- 2. Parks is currently working on developing this park property.
- 3. During the land use review process, it was discovered that the sewer line benefiting the adjacent property at 2525 SE 47<sup>th</sup> is encroaching on the Park.
- The Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code Section 721 provides that private sewers may 4. not be located on property lots other than the lot served by the sewer unless an easement is provided in a form that is acceptable to the Bureau of Development Services.
- 5. In order to complete the land use review process needed to begin development of the Park, the sewer line must be relocated or the City must grant an easement to bring the sewer line into compliance with Code.
- 6. Parks wishes to grant a sewer easement to the adjacent property owners (Grantees). Among other conditions, it will require the Grantees to be responsible for all maintenance and repair costs.

## NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- The Director of Parks and Recreation is authorized to execute an easement a. agreement, substantially similar to the attached and approved as to form by the City Attorney, that grants a non-exclusive sewer easement.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the development of the Park; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
