ORDINANCE No. 183558

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with US Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service to prevent bird nesting on the N Vancouver Ave Bridge over the Columbia Slough (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland is in the process of contracting for the replacement of the N Vancouver Avenue Bridge over the Columbia Slough.
- 2. Several bird nesting sites were observed during an inspection of the bridge by staff from Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) and the US Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service in the fall of 2009.
- 3. The US Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (USDA) has federal statutory authority to remove existing nests and prevent nesting activities in accordance with the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.
- 4. The USDA has prepared a Cooperative Services Agreement to provide services prior to and during the course of construction of the N Vancouver Avenue Bridge replacement.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is optimal in that the fees for the service are specified in the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the US Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, substantially in accordance with the document attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the services needed under this agreement are best initiated prior to the start of the nesting season in March 2010; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
