ORDINANCE No. 183656

*Authorize application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering and Tracking for a grant in the amount of \$150,000 for the SMART FY 2010 Comprehensive Approaches to Sex Offender Management Grant Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Office
 of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering, and Tracking
 (SMART) will make Comprehensive Approaches to Sex Offender Management Grant
 Program (CASOM) funds available to jurisdictions to enhance existing sex offender
 management practices or implement an innovative strategy that can be recognized as best
 practice.
- 2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for SMART funding in order to enhance the Bureau's Sex Offender Registration program by focusing on field address verification and enforcement in accordance with the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA).
- 3. If awarded, the USDOJ will reimburse the City for officer overtime, mandatory training workshops and program supplies not to exceed the grant application request of \$150,000.
- 4. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2012. No match is required for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office of Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering, and Tracking (SMART) for a grant in the amount of \$150,000 and in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
