1) Legislation Title:

* Implement a temporary suspension of Park system development charges for qualified accessory dwelling units. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

This Ordinance was directed by Council in order to implement Resolution 36766 Suspending systems development charges for Parks and Recreation, Environmental Services, Transportation, and Water for the construction of accessory dwelling units or the conversion of structures to accessory dwelling units until June 30, 2013.

3) Revenue:

Will this legislation generate or reduce current or future revenue coming to the City? If so, by how much? If new revenue is generated please identify the source.

Parks has estimated that based on past performance the suspension of the Park SDC for ADUs for a three year period could result in foregone revenue of approximate \$175,000.

If the strategy is successful in stimulating construction of an increased number of ADUs Parks has estimated the foregone revenue could exceed \$425,000.
