Authorize three-party agreement with Multnomah County Department of county Human Services – School and Community Partnerships and the Reynolds School District No. 7 for the SUN Community Schools initiative and SUN Service System (Ordinance). Authorize three-party agreement with Multnoman County

The City of Portland ordains: District School District Sentential Partners and the Reynolds School and Community Partnerships and the Reynolds School District Sentential Programmes and Indiana.

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Education is the primary responsibility of the schools, and extended-day programs provide new opportunities to motivate, enrich and support student learning.
- 2. Many considerations effect the quality of young people's education, including social, health and emotional concerns. Comprehensive models address these concerns.
- 3. Bridges between the extended program and the regular school curriculum can help raise academic achievement. The extended learning school curriculum should be challenging, fun and reflect diverse strengths and interests.
- 4. Involving families as decision-makers, volunteers, and participants in activities with their children and other adults is vital to success. MEDIAT MOITOR
- 5. All community members should have the opportunity to play a role in the community schools model.
- 6. Youth should be involved as resources in the provision of change versus being seen as the objects of the planning of change.
- 7. Public school facilities should be made accessible for community utilization.
- 8. SUN Community Schools embrace the principle of involving and working together with everybody in the community, a goal shared by the City of Portland.
- 9. Portland Parks & Recreation wishes to continue their partnership with Multnomah County and the Reynolds School District No. 7 to continue the success brought forth by the SUN Community Schools program.
- 10. The City will provide funding to the County, through a separate Agreement and Ordinance. A portion of that funding will be offered to these Districts.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with Multnomah County and Reynolds School District, substantially in the form of this Agreement attached to this Ordinance, in support of SUN Community Schools at specific Reynolds School District No. 7 school locations.
