ATTACHMENT A TRN-3.450 – TRANSPORTATION FEE SCHEDULE

Binding City Policy BCP-TRN-3.450

COMPLIANCE WITH CITY FINANCIAL POLICY (FIN-2.06)

Transportation adheres to City policy (FIN-2.06) regarding services that benefit a specific user and whose quantity, quality, and/or number of units as may be specified should be paid for by fees and charges. The following fees and structures take into account:

- The degree to which a service provides a general benefit in addition to the private benefit provided to a specific business, property or individual;
- The economic impact of new or expanded fees, especially in comparison with other governments within the metropolitan area;
- The true or comprehensive cost of providing a service, including the cost of fee collection and administration;
- The impact of imposing or increasing fees on economically at-risk populations and on businesses; and
- The overall achievement of City goals.

As stipulated in FIN-2.06, all fee revenues listed in this schedule are dedicated to the Bureau of Transportation.

COST OF SERVICES

Transportation fees shall recover full costs of services including all direct costs, loss of interest and depreciation on capital plant and equipment, and applicable indirect (overhead) charges, as computed annually and approved by the Commissioner-in-Charge. Certain premiums may be applied to discourage use/abuse and/or subsidies may be applied in compliance with mandated City and Transportation policy goals, including remaining competitive within the region.

A bureau cost of service analysis is completed on a minimum of every two years. Price methodologies, costs and fee assessments are reviewed and approved by the City as part of the bureau's Adopted Budget process; fees are updated annually effective July 1st of each new fiscal year. The attached Exhibit A and Exhibit B are the Bureau of Transportation's Fee Schedules.

MINOR PRICE ADJUSTMENTS

Occasional adjustments to fees and charges for activities, permits, and product sales are within the public interest in order to optimize utilization and operations of existing facilities based on a poor economy, usage, pricing errors or other variables. For example, Transportation may scale back and/or discontinue product sales operations due to a poor economy, which might then require a reduction and/or elimination of a product fee.

The Bureau Director is authorized to modify fees, charges and product sales for minor adjustments for inflation, reductions in operations, comparable regional fees and other cases where the net change is less than 25%, without returning to Council. Notification of pending

price adjustments will be posted to Portland Online – Transportation and directly communicated to effected service/product users 30 days in advance of any change.

FEE WAIVERS

The City Council has mandated that the bureau support its services with fees and charges. When fees are waived, the bureau still provides the service even though it is not reimbursed for cost of services delivered.

The Commissioner in charge of Transportation and/or delegate shall have the discretion and authority to waive a portion or all of a bureau-related permit fee.

Fee Waiver Procedure

Fee waiver requests shall be made in writing to the Commissioner in charge of Transportation, stating the reason for waiving the fee. Financial and other supporting documentation should be included with the request (i.e. current tax returns, bank statements, IRS 501c3, etc). Financial information provided by the applicant will remain confidential to the extent permitted under Oregon public records law.
