**ORDINANCE No. 183833**

Authorize an Intergovernmental Grant Agreement with the Portland Development Commission regarding a financial contribution to fund the final design and construction of the South Corridor Phase II: Portland-Milwaukie Light Rail Project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. City Council adopted Resolution No. 36625 on July 17, 2008, specifying a new Locally Preferred Alternative for the South Corridor Phase II: Portland-Milwaukie Light Rail Project (PLMR).
2. The total project cost is estimated to be \$1.417 billion dollars and, under local funding match requirement, the City of Portland contribution to the local match is \$30 million dollars.
3. On February 24, 2010, City Council passed Ordinance 183554, which authorized TriMet and the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), committed the City to \$30 million dollar City of Portland contribution to the South Corridor Phase II: Portland-Milwaukie Light Rail Project, and outlined the City's funding plan for the contribution.
4. The funding plan includes a \$10 million dollar contribution of Tax Increment Financing from the Portland Development Commission.
5. In Ordinance 183554, Council directed the Portland Bureau of Transportation to prepare an IGA between the Bureau of Transportation and the Portland Development Commission for the PDC's \$10 million dollar contribution and bring back to Council for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Grant Agreement between the City of Portland and PDC, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to the original of this ordinance and by this reference made a part hereof.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants when demand is presented and approved by proper authorities.
