

ORDINANCE No. 183871

Authorize on-call contract with TestAmerica Laboratories, Inc. for laboratory services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), Water Pollution Control Laboratory (WPCL) requires environmental analytical services on an as-needed basis for analyses for which the WPCL does not have the proper instrumentation and/or expertise, or workload exceeds WPCL capacity.
2. The outside laboratory services are time sensitive and are a regulatory requirement of the City's wastewater, storm water, and underground injection control permits, and failure to provide such services may expose the City to stipulated penalties under the terms of said permits.
3. A Request For Proposals for these services was issued on March 25, 2010 (RFP BES-104). Six proposals were received. TestAmerica Laboratories was selected as the highest-scoring respondent.
4. There is no M/W/ESB participation on this contract.
5. The established cost is not to exceed \$1,050,000.00 for the initial three-year term of the contract. The contract may be renewed for two additional one-year periods at a cost not to exceed \$350,000.00 per each additional year. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011 Approved Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, ESPP000011, Account No. 521000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with TestAmerica, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$1,050,000.00.
- b. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute contract amendments renewing the contract for two additional, one-year periods at a cost not to exceed \$350,000.00 per year.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
