2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The City wishes to apply for grant funding on behalf of the JAG-designated disparate jurisdictions, the County of Multnomah and the City of Gresham. The City will serve as fiscal agent and administrator for the grant. An intergovernmental agreement will be executed with each jurisdiction in order to obligate agency roles and responsibilities. The grant award will be made during the first year of the appropriation and may be expended during the following three years, for a total of four grant period years.

The USDOJ will reimburse the City of Portland up to \$824,764 for approved program expenses. The allocations are projected as follows: City of Portland, \$405,649; Multnomah County, \$318,723 and City of Gresham, \$100,392.
