ORDINANCE No. 183902

Create a new represented premium assignment of Electrician/Instrument Technician, Lead and establish an interim compensation rate (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating a new represented premium assignment effective April 21, 2010.
- 2. The business needs that this premium assignment classification is intended to meet cannot be fulfilled until the premium assignment classification and wage rate are established, however the wage rate for the premium assignment classification must be collectively bargained with District Council of Trade Unions (DCTU), AFSCME, Local 189. Under Article 26.5.1 of the DCTU contract, the City may establish an interim rate during bargaining.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The following premium assignment classification is being created:
