

ORDINANCE NO. 183908

* Authorize application to Department of Homeland Security, Assistance to Firefighters Fire Grant Program for a grant in the amount of \$720,000 for the purchase of one aerial fire apparatus (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through its Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), has offered the Assistance to Firefighters Fire Grant Program since 2001. The grant funds a variety of programs, including those to enhance emergency operations, firefighter safety, and prevention efforts.
2. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) has developed a grant proposal for the purchase of one new aerial apparatus.
3. The City of Portland Grants and Contracts Office is aware of this grant application.
4. FEMA requires a twenty (20) percent local matching fund for this prevention grant.
5. Local match in the amount of \$180,000 will be provided by funds from FY 2010-2011 PF&R vehicle replacement budget.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to FEMA for a grant in the amount of \$720,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant application period closed on May 28, 2010. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
