Bureau of Environmental Services

Sewer Volume Charge: Pays for sewage treatment and sewer system construction, maintenance and repair. Residential sewer volume charges are based on winter average water use, or actual use, whichever is lower. Commercial sewer volume charges are based on actual water use.

Stormwater Charge: The off-site charge pays for construction, operation and maintenance of facilities that manage stormwater runoff from city streets. The on-site charge pays for facilities that manage stormwater runoff from private property.

Clean River Rewards: Managing stormwater on your property can earn you a discount of up to 100% of the on-site stormwater management charges. Go to www.CleanRiverRewards.com or call 503-823-1371 for more information.


