# INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TRIMET AND CITY OF PORTLAND FOR PORTLAND MALL REVITALIZATION PROJECT DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES

#### THIRD AMENDMENT

#### TriMet Contract No. GH070428TL City Contract No. C52972

THIS Third Amendment to the Portland Mall Revitalization Project Design And Construction Management Services Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of the effective date identified below the signatures to this Agreement and is between the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon ("TriMet") and the City of Portland ("City") (TriMet and City collectively are hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"). This Third Amendment is written to make the following changes to the Agreement. All provisions of the Agreement shall remain in effect unless modified or superseded by this Third Amendment.

#### Changes to Article I – TERM

The expiration date of the Agreement is hereby changed from June 30, 2010 to June 30, 2011.

## Changes to Article II – TRIMET OBLIGATIONS

- 1. Article II is amended by adding paragraphs V, W, and X as follows:
  - V. **Brick Intersection Maintenance.** Provide services related to the maintenance and repair of brick intersections. The cost for this work is \$31,425 which will be paid by City.
  - W. **Repair to Thermoplastic Striping/Marking.** Provide services related to the repair of storm damage to the thermoplastic striping and marking. The cost for such work is \$32,200 which will be split equally by the Parties.
  - X. Installation of Additional Bike Racks. TriMet, the City, and Portland Mall Management, Inc. (PMMI) will cooperatively procure and install additional bike racks on the Mall. The purchase cost for the racks of \$19,800 will be split evenly between TriMet and the City. PMMI will arrange and pay for installation of the racks at no cost to TriMet or the City

## Changes to Article IV - CITY SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

1. Article IV (E) 1. is amended to add the following paragraph:

- (j) The City's Right-of-Way Acquisition group will perform the work necessary to vacate NW Irving Street between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenues. The cost of such work is estimated at \$6,000 and will be paid by TriMet.
- 2. Article IV (E) 4. is replaced in its entirety by the following:
  - 4. <u>Bureau of Maintenance</u>. Under the coordination of the City's Project Manager, the Bureau of Maintenance shall provide services as described below:
    - (a) The Bureau of Maintenance will install permanent parking/truck loading signs upon project completion. The scope of services during construction (signal turn on/offs, temporary striping and/or signage) will be determined based on 100% construction plans and this agreement will be amended as necessary.
    - (b) The Bureau of Maintenance has installed additional traffic signage on the Transit Mall and will install supplemental signage related to the settlement of the Erickson Realty claim. The cost of installing such signage is estimated at \$5,000 which is within the budget set forth in this Agreement, and will be paid by TriMet.
    - (c) The Bureau of Maintenance will install preferential lane signage on the Transit Mall. The cost of installing such signage is estimated at \$8,000 which is within the budget set forth in this Agreement, and will be paid by TriMet.

### Changes to Exhibit F – Summary of Costs

Replace Exhibit F with an amended Exhibit F "Summary of Costs" (attached) to reflect changes in compensation between TriMet and the City for the above work, along with adjustments to reflect actual costs for PWB system alterations, relocations and betterments.

There are no other changes to the Agreement and all other terms of the Agreement shall remain the same.
