1) Legislation Title:

* Ratify a Letter of Agreement between the City and Portland Police Association authorizing the compensation of Doug Tang for certain overtime opportunities denied to him. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The City and the PPA are parties to a Labor Agreement, the term of which is July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2010. Article 23, Section 23.11 of the parties' CBA provides "... overtime shall be offered, in the order of seniority, to officers in the reporting unit."

Doug Tang was assigned as an NRT Sergeant, and was denied opportunity to work overtime as a Precinct Sergeant on the grounds that it was not within his reporting unit. PPA filed a grievance on 3/17/2004 (PPA#2004-04; L/ER# 2004-046); Grievant has alleged denial of 320 hours of overtime opportunity.

The matter has been in abeyance so settlement negotiations could be completed. The parties conclude that it would be mutually beneficial to resolve this matter by means of a grievance settlement agreement. Said settlement would advance the interests of the City.
