

# ORDINANCE No. 184029

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County and accept a grant in the amount of \$175,000 for Communities Putting Prevention to Work provided through American Reinvestment & Recovery Act (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability submitted a proposal in the amount of \$200,000 to Multnomah County to be included in the County's application to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for a *Communities Putting Prevention to Work* grant provided through American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) 2009.
2. Multnomah County was awarded a \$7.5 million grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The County has notified the City of Portland that it will receive a grant for the *Communities Putting Prevention to Work* project to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$175,000. The FY 2010-11 Adopted Budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability includes \$100,000 to fund the project expenses, with the remaining \$75,000 to be appropriated in FY 2011-12 to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Multnomah County for the *Communities Putting Prevention to Work* project in the amount of \$175,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of attached Exhibit A for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that there be no delay performing services on behalf of the County's grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
