

ORDINANCE NO. 184094

* Authorize grant application to the Environmental Protection Agency for \$465,000 for development of the Sustainable Transportation and Access Rating System (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is soliciting projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions for its Climate Showcase Communities grant program.
2. The Climate Action Plan calls for the Bureau of Transportation to reduce its carbon emissions by 40% by 2030.
3. The Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) has committed resources to the development of a project rating system called STARS, or Sustainable Transportation and Access Rating System, to reduce the carbon emissions from transportation projects. PBOT is seeking additional resources and partnerships to help complete the development of STARS.
4. Local match in the amount of \$350,000 will be provided by time and resource contributions from project partners other than the City of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a grant in the amount of \$465,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grants are due immediately, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
