ORDINANCE No. 184125

Authorize a contract and provide for payment to furnish replacement dump trucks at \$1,190,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the 12-15 yard dump trucks used by Bureau of Environmental Services and Water Bureau.
- 3. It has been determined that four dump trucks need to be replaced for BES vehicles #86257, #86258, #86389, and #86488, and three for Water Bureau, #984201, #994505, and #994206.
- 4. The estimated cost of replacing these trucks is \$170,000 each, or \$1,190,000 for the seven dump trucks.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to issue a purchase order for these vehicles in accordance with City Code 5.33.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from the CityFleet Replacement Fund.
