Clean Energy Works Overview

- Outcome of Climate Action Plan and Economic Development Strategy
- Residential retrofit packages
- 500-home pilot (June 2009 December 2010)
- Low-cost, long-term financing with utility on-bill repayment
- "High-touch" customer service
- Strong workforce agreement to ensure quality jobs and equity in contracting, hiring and training

Results to Date

- Loans signed = 327
- Retrofits completed = 257
- Jobs created = 10 direct construction, ~12 non-construction, private-sector jobs
- Community workforce goals:
 - 20% pilot \$ to M/W/DBE
 - 50% hours worked by underrepresented workers
- Carbon reductions = 2.7 metric tons per home







Goals for Scale-Up

- At least 6,000 units within 3 years, state-wide
- 1,300 quality jobs created
- Energy savings > 300,000 MBTUs
- Measure-life CO2 reductions > 200,000 metric tons
- More equity results
- Increased lending
- Improved building stock
