ORDINANCE No. 184192

Amend contract with CH2M HILL for additional application software development on the wet weather flow primary treatment system at the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Project No. E05512 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 38083)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) treats the City's wastewater in accordance with State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issued NPDES permit requirements.
- 2. The wet weather flow primary treatment system at CBWTP is being expanded to add a wet weather flow screening facility (WWSF) and a chemical enhanced primary treatment (CEPT) facility. The WWSF is part of the ASFO (Amended Stipulation Final Order), which will have been completed and operational by Dec 1, 2011, while the CEPT will improve the primary treatment system capacity.
- 3. The existing facilities in the primary treatment system are automatically controlled (on specifically developed application software programs), and so will the facilities being added. CBWTP has a need to update, coordinate and integrate the existing application programs with the new application programs.
- 4. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need for continuing professional engineering services provided by CH2M HILL to integrate the controls of the WWSF and CEPT facilities. CH2M HILL is continuing to provide professional engineering services under Contract No. 38083 for the WWSF, effective 6/20/08 and extended expiration of 12/31/11.
- 5. The estimated cost for this contract amendment is \$178,302. The cost estimate level of confidence rating is optimal. There is no M/W/ESB participation in this contract amendment. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 10-11 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS E05512.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute Contract Amendment No 3 for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
