## 184223 **ORDINANCE** No.

\*Approve settlement of claims with Kerr Contractors, Inc. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In October 2008, the City of Portland, Bureau of Environmental Services ("BES"), filed a lawsuit against Kerr Contractors, Inc. ("Kerr"), entitled City of Portland v. Kerr Contractors, Inc., MCCC Case No. 0801-14326, asserting claims for breach of contract and negligence.
- 2. Kerr has agreed to settle with BES as shown in the attached Exhibit 1 (Settlement Agreement with Kerr). The City Attorney's office and BES recommend approval of this settlement by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Director of BES is authorized to execute the Settlement Agreement a. with Kerr Contractors, Inc., in substantially similar form to that attached as Exhibit 1 to this Ordinance. Funds received pursuant to this ordinance shall be placed in BES's account.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
