

ORDINANCE No. 184234

Authorize Collaborative Agreement between Portland Parks & Recreation and Portland Public Schools for the joint use of facilities. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) and Portland Public Schools (PPS) are mutually interested in providing programs, facilities and services that benefit children, their families, and the Portland community, and recognize that through a comprehensive collaboration they can enhance the quality and quantity of the programs, facilities, and services they collectively offer.
2. PP&R and PPS, through numerous agreements, have a long history of using each other's facilities to meet their facility needs for sports and other programming. Joint use agreements between PP&R and PPS date back to at least 1957.
3. PP&R and PPS wish to enter into this Collaboration Agreement to consolidate all the previous use agreements into one overarching agreement that will provide a flexible and consistent framework for managing and expanding shared use and joint development of facilities more effectively and efficiently.
4. The terms of the Agreement also promotes communication between PP&R and PPS by establishing a Strategic Committee of representatives from both parties to work collaboratively on cross-agency concerns and ventures.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Director of Parks and Recreation is authorized to execute the Collaboration Agreement for the Joint Use of Portland Public Schools and Portland Parks & Recreation Facilities, in a form substantially similar to the attached Agreement, with its attached Exhibits A, B and C and as approved as to form by the City Attorney.
