History of Agenda Item/Background:

The State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality provides grants to local jurisdictions around the State. By law, the grants must go to local governments, but local governments may contract with community groups to implement projects. State DEQ awarded a grant of \$13,070 to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability for transfer to Skyline School to implement ways to divert waste from the regional landfills.

Purpose of Agenda Item

Authorize amendment of Agreement 32000451 with Skyline School to support, promote and expand existing conservation efforts at the school. Work is to be completed by December 31, 2010, while the expiration of the agreement is extended to February 28, 2011 for billing purposes.

6. Legal Issues:

The original grant agreement with Skyline School failed to include a provision for amendment of that agreement, so the City Attorney has determined it is necessary to return to City Council to authorize minor amendments that extend the date and specify tasks to be completed by December 31, 2010.
