

## ORDINANCE No. 184238

\*Amend contract with TransCore ITS, Inc. for \$86,820 to enhance the TransSuite traffic signal control system software features (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 34742)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City Council, on April 2, 2003, approved Ordinance No. 177357, authorizing Contract No. 34742 between the City and TransCore ITS, Inc. The contract provided \$650,000 for the upgrading of the City's aging traffic signal computer hardware and software system.
2. On September 15, 2005, City Council approved Ordinance No. 179582, amending Contract No. 34742 between the City and TransCore ITS, Inc. and authorizing an additional \$311,810.84 in compensation for providing software to the Central Traffic Signal System Replacement Project.
3. The additional funding for the last phase of this project is derived from Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds and distributed through ODOT.
4. Compensation allowed under this Ordinance has increased the contract to a maximum amount of \$1,048,631.25.
5. New contract number 30001560 has been assigned to this agreement because of requirements under the City's current Enterprise Business Solution system, SAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to sign and execute the amendment to contract number 34742, substantially in accordance with the amendment document attached to the original of this Ordinance and by reference made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because TransCore needs to be paid in a timely manner as work has been completed; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


