1) Legislation Title:

* Authorize subrecipient intergovernmental agreement with City of Gresham for \$1,856,455 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program and provide for payment. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The Portland HOME Consortium, of which the City of Gresham is a member, is a recipient of funding under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnership Program.

In accordance with the HOME Consortium Agreement (No. 51985), a portion of the HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.

There is a total of \$1,952,262 in HOME funds available to Gresham in the Portland Housing Bureau budget, comprised of \$625,127 in FY 2010-11 Gresham HOME funds and \$1,327,135 in FY 2009-10 carryover funds. The City of Gresham will implement a portion of the HOME Program in the amount of \$1,856,455 in accordance with the Budget (Attachment A). The balance of Gresham's HOME Program funding (\$95,807) will be administered by the City of Portland.
