#### Amendment No. 1

The above referenced Subrecipient Contract between the City of Portland, acting by and through its Portland Housing Bureau, and 211 *info* is hereby amended as follows:

- I. <u>Scope of Services / Uses of Funds:</u> Section I.H and Section I.I, Scope of Services is amended to read:
  - H. Street Count work to begin November 1, 2010
     1. Work with City, key stakeholders, and Outreach and Engagement Workgroup to coordinate planning and preparations for the January 2011 bi-annual Homeless Street Count. This includes development of a methodology, survey forms, site lists, and logistical plans
    - 2. Work with potential Street Count partners and sites to coordinate their involvement in the count.
    - 3. Work with City and Multnomah County to coordinate the Street Count and One Night Shelter Count (ONSC).
    - 4. Recruit, train, and coordinate volunteers to assist with the Street Count.
    - 5. Develop all materials for sites and partners, including coordinating and conducting trainings.
    - 6. Analyze all data in coordination with City HMIS staff.
    - 7. Research and write the final Street Count report, incorporating feedback from City, O&E Workgroup members, and other key stakeholders. This may include coordinating with Multnomah County to write a joint report that incorporates the ONSC data.
    - 8. Present the Street Count findings to key stakeholders as requested.
    - 9. Evaluate Street Count methodology and develop recommendations for future counts.
  - I. Any changes to this scope of services shall be requested in writing by the Subrecipient and approved in writing by the Project Manager.

### II. Compensation:

Item 4, Compensation on page 1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced to read:

4. Compensation

The amount of compensation shall not exceed \$223,800 in the City's FY 2010-11 Budget (\$170,800 in CDBG Fund, \$53,000 in General Fund). The compensation requirements are contained in Section II.

Section II, B, Compensation and Method of Payment is deleted in its entirety and replaced to read:

B. It is agreed that total compensation under this Contract shall not exceed TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$223,800).
