ORDINANCE No. 184323

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to partner on a salmon and lamprey monitoring program for Tryon Creek basin. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In March 2000, the Portland City Council adopted the Clean River Plan, which included monitoring and watershed assessment to determine project effectiveness and partnering with other jurisdictions.
- 2. The Portland City Council adopted the Framework for Integrated Management of Watershed Health on March 8, 2006 as part of the adoption of the 2005 Portland Watershed Management Plan. The Framework offers a definition of healthy urban watersheds, a vision for the future of Portland's watersheds, and watershed health goals including biological communities. Salmon are highlighted as particular interest because of their special legal, economic and cultural status in the Pacific Northwest.
- 3. The United State Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) works with partners to conserve, protect and enhance fish, wildlife, and plants and their habitats for the continuing benefit of the American people.
- 4. The Bureau of Environmental Services and USFWS have agreed to partner for five years to monitor salmon and lamprey presence in the Tryon Creek Basin to study stream enhancement effectiveness and determine needs for future projects. The established cost is \$53,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY10/11 (\$20,000) and FY 11/12-14/15 (\$8,250 each year) Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, ESWS000006, ESWS000009, and ESWS000011.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with USFWS for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$53,000.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute amendments to this intergovernmental agreement that do not increase the agreement amount.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
