ORDINANCE No. 184326

* Authorize contract with lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Fire Station 18 Seismic Upgrade and Facility Remodel project for estimated cost of \$1,509,700. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Fire Station 31 Seismic Upgrade and Facility Remodel project is estimated to be \$1,509,700. The construction estimate is within the program budget.
- 2. The project goals include, but are not limited to, a seismic upgrade to essential facilities status and a total facility remodel incorporating gender-related accommodations, ADA improvements, a community meeting room, and LEED Gold certification.
- 3. The design is complete and the construction documents are being prepared to go out to public bid.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Fire Station 18 Seismic Upgrade and Facility Remodel project in accordance with the plans and specifications to be filed with the Purchasing Agent.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the fiscal year 2010-2011 Fire and Rescue Facilities GO Bond Construction Fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
