ORDINANCE No. 184410

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the NE Sandy Blvd; 47th to 82nd Road Rehabilitation project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pavement conditions on NE Sandy Blvd. between NE 47th Avenue and NE 82nd Avenue have deteriorated to a point where they have been prioritized for significant preventative maintenance and rehabilitation.
- 2. NE Sandy Blvd. is a principle arterial roadway within the City carrying over 20,000 vehicles, trucks, and busses per day. This portion of NE Sandy Blvd. is classified in the City's Comprehensive Plan as a Major City Traffic Street, Major City Transit Street, Major Truck Route, and City Bikeway.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation has prepared plans, specifications and an estimate for the preventative maintenance and rehabilitation of this roadway.
- 4. Funds to construct, inspect, and manage this project are available in the FY 2010-2011 budget.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high. The Project is defined and plans and specifications are complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00179 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing this Ordinance will delay award of the project affecting the project completion, and not encumber funds budgeted in the current FY; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
