## 1) Legislation Title:

\* Authorize a grant agreement with the Police Activities League of Greater Portland to create evening access to youth for recreational basketball during the evening hours of Spring Break 2011 (Ordinance)

#### 2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

The PAL Youth Center, located at 424 NE 172<sup>nd</sup> Ave., will be able to expand service hours during the week of Spring Break March 21<sup>st</sup> through March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011 to be open from 6 PM to 10PM. The expansion of youth programming provided by this grant agreement will allow youth residing in Portland, ages 12 through 18 years old, access to an existing youth center gymnasium specifically for recreational basketball, during hours that the facility would normally be closed. As estimated by PAL Youth Center staff, minimally 50 youth per evening will be provided recreation in a secure, safe and supervised environment. Additionally, it will provide transportation to and from the center as needed, food and beverages, and the ability to resurface the existing basketball gym floor In kind staffing resources will be provided by the Portland Police Bureau through the Youth Services Division.

#### 4) Expense:
