ORDINANCE No. 184559

*Authorize grant application to the Oregon State Marine Board Boating Facilities Program in the amount of \$372,375 for repair and maintenance at the Willamette Park boat ramp (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Willamette Park boat ramp is located at Mile 15.8 on the Willamette River. It is the largest and busiest public boat ramp facility within the Willamette reach in Portland. It is also the only public facility located on the west side of the river.
- 2. Portland Parks & Recreation owns, operates, and maintains the facility. The entire facility was upgraded in 1997 and the marine infrastructure remains in good condition.
- 3. The Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) grant application proposes repair of the toe ramp, along with dredging maintenance. Both of these efforts will insure the facility lasts its full life cycle of 20-25 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to OSMB for a grant in the amount of \$372,375.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be delivered by May 20, 2011; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
