* Authorize an agreement with Multnomah County to continue funding of mental health services at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

This legislation extends the current contract for mental health services through June 30, 2011. Mental health services are extremely important and valuable to survivors of domestic violence. At the Gateway Center, mental health services are requested and accessed at higher rates than the Department of Human Services Self Sufficiency services (which includes emergency monetary relief). Similarly, more survivors request and access mental health services than prosecution and police combined.
