Last February, the Portland Housing Bureau completed an extensive evaluation of Dignity Village. There were numerous recommendations that will require several more months of meetings to address. These will possibly result in significant changes to a contract with the Village going forward.

Dignity Village's current contract with the City of Portland will expire at the end of June 2011. This contract, signed in May 2007, designates Dignity Village as the manager of the transitional campground sited at Sunderland Yard.

Dignity Village has successfully sheltered 60 homeless people each night, year round. The Village has developed and enforced basic rules of conduct, including a screening and evictions process. More than 90% of stakeholders interviewed for the evaluation support the City's renewal of Dignity Village's contract.
