1. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On February 2, 2011 City Council approved Resolution #36844 to create an independent citizen committee for specific City of Portland technology projects and directed OMF to prepare all necessary changes to City Code and Administrative Rules. On April 6, 2011 City Council held its first reading of City Code changes and received a Report to Council on the status of the draft Administrative Rules 1.07 and 4.01. On April 13, 2011, City Council voted to adopt the City Code changes.

With this ordinance Council will adopt BTS Administrative Rule 1.07 – Technology Project Oversight. BTS Administrative Rule 4.01 was approved through the standard process requiring Chief Administrative Officer's review and approval.
