**2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:**

The Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ) Criminal Justice Division has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for marijuana eradication and suppression to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$20,000. The City will authorize signing of the Letter of Understanding and Amendment No. 1, which obligate the roles and responsibilities of both parties. The grant period is January 1 - December 31, 2011.
