7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Pursuant to its obligations under ORS 243.650 et. seq. the City entered into labor contract negotiations with the Laborers' Local 483 – Seasonal Maintenance Worker. If ratified, this Tentative Agreement will establish the terms and conditions for a Labor Agreement for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The Wage and Compensation set aside for the General Fund includes the monies necessary to fund the CPI-W increase in wages and benefits. Certain costs associated with Health Care Benefits have also been set aside in the General Fund.
