The USDOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$199,883 for expenses incurred by the bureau for IPCEP personnel overtime hours, training, travel, and program supplies. An intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County will provide for the personnel expenses for a 0.5 FTE Deputy District

Attorney.
