AMENDMENT NO. 1

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR TRANSIT SYSTEM SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF PORTLAND

This Amendment made the day of _____, 2011, modifies the Intergovernmental Agreement between the TRI-COUNTY METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT OF OREGON, hereinafter referred to as "TriMet", and THE CITY OF PORTLAND, hereinafter referred to as "City" for design and construction of transit system safety improvements.

RECITALS

Whereas, on September 29, 2010, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 184133 authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement between TriMet and the City for design and construction of transit system safety improvements; and

Whereas, the first agreed upon project to make modifications to NW Thurman has been completed; and

Whereas, Portland Bureau of Transportation and TriMet wish to continue this partnership for mutually agreed upon work on transit system safety projects; and

Whereas, at TriMet's request, PBOT has begun work on a second safety improvement and seeks to continue this partnership in the future.

AGREEMENT

1. The authorized contract amount is hereby revised. The new contract amount is \$250,000, in lieu of \$50,000, for an increase of \$200,000.

2. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CITY/TRIMET AGREEMENT ARE UNCHANGED.
