

ORDINANCE No. 184901

*Authorize charitable organizations eligible to participate in the City's 2012 Combined Charitable Campaign. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 161964, adopted by Council on May 24, 1989, established standards and guidelines for conducting charitable fund-raising campaigns and authorized the use of the payroll deduction system for making donations to charities.
2. The fifteen agencies and foundations listed below are seeking City Council approval to participate in the 2012 Combined Charitable Campaign.
3. The requirement of Section 5.10 that the participating agencies be umbrella organizations was waived for the Portland Toy & Joymakers.
4. The requirements of Section 5.10 that the participating agencies be umbrella organizations and that participating agencies not exceed 25 percent of its unrestricted income were waived for the Portland Parks Foundation.
5. All other participating agencies have met the Code requirements outlined in Section 5.10. The City's Charitable Campaign Committee recommends that Council approve the participation of these organizations in the 2012 Campaign.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The following umbrella organizations and their member organizations are eligible to participate in the City's 2012 Combined Charitable Campaign.

 - Black United Fund of Oregon
 - Children's Trust Fund of Oregon
 - Community Health Charities of Oregon
 - Earth Share of Oregon
 - Equity Foundation
 - Global Impact
 - Local Independent Charities
 - McKenzie River Gathering Foundation
 - Portland Fire Bureau Toy & Joymakers
 - Portland Parks Foundation
 - Portland Schools Foundation
 - Work for Art (Regional Arts & Culture Council)

- Sunshine Division of the Portland Police Bureau
- United Way of the Columbia-Willamette

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no delay in implementing the City's 2012 Combined Charitable Campaign; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


