## 7. BACKGROUND ANALYSIS

On September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011, Council amended d Portland City Code 14B.120 Time Place and Manner Regulations of Establishments that Serve Alcohol (TPM code). The memorandum of understanding included in the original enactment of the Code in 2004 needs to be updated to reflect Councils decision.

Although Section 14B.120.025 grants specific authority to the ONI Director and the Chief of Police to adopt rules, procedures and forms to implement the provisions of PCC Chapter 14B.120, their authority to do so is unclear because the original Memorandum of Understanding was approved by Council.

## 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the proposed administrative amendments.

#### 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the amendments to the Memorandum of Understanding for PCC 14B.120. Direct that future amendment to policy documents may be approved by the Direct of the Office of neighborhood Involvement and/or the Chief of Police.
