ORDINANCE No. 184962

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$65,000 and appropriate \$50,000 for FY 2011-12 from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (OACP), for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program grant on September 21, 2011; and
- 2. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$65,000; and
- 3. The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police will reimburse the City a maximum of \$65,000 for Police Bureau Traffic Division sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2012 DUII and HVE program. The reimbursement rate is \$40.00 per hour; and
- 4. The local match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided by funds from City of Portland matching funds in the form of personnel expenses (straight time hours in support of DUII enforcement, overtime expenses incurred above the grant's \$40.00 per hour reimbursement rate and all benefit expenses related to grant overtime and straight time) in the FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 budgets of the Police Bureau; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program in the amount of \$65,000.
- b. The FY 2011-2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217
Business Area - PL00
Bureau Program Expenses - \$50,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police for the 2012 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program, #K8-12-12-38, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
