7. <u>BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS</u> On or about June 20, 2011, the OBCD initiated a training program for the SSPVI and SPI certifications. The OBCD plans to offer a training program for the SEI and SFI certifications at a later date. The OBCD plans to offer additional SSPVI and SPI certification training programs in the Fall and Winter of 2011 and in 2012. The Bureau will pay the cost for employees to attend these certification training programs. Once employees successfully complete the SSPVI, SPI, SEI or SFI certification training programs, the Bureau may assign employees those inspection duties. The Bureau will pay a certification premium of \$0.80 cents per hour for all hours worked conducting SSPVI, SPI, SEI, or SFI on commercial properties, rounded up to the next fifteen (15) minute increment.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The City estimates that it will cost up to \$1,600 per year. The City estimates that we will steadily increase our budget for this premium, as follows:
