

ORDINANCE No. 185130

Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the East Lents Floodplain Restoration Project - Phase 2 No. E08464 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has a need to construct Phase 2 of the East Lents Floodplain Restoration Project, which is identified in the June 2001 Johnson Creek Restoration Plan as Reach 15.
2. The project is needed to achieve the following goals identified in the Plan; mitigation of nuisance flooding, reconnection and restoration of the floodplain, stabilization of stream banks, increase in-stream complexity, and enhance upland and riparian habitat.
3. The estimated construction cost is \$2,538,622. The level of confidence is high.
4. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2011-2012 and FY 2012-2013 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E08464, Internal Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


