On August 17, 2011 the City of Portland passed Ordinance 184814, authorizing the Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) to apply to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a grant from the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP). The Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management has notified the City of Portland that it will award an SHSGP FY 2011 grant to PBEM in the amount of \$40,000 for support of the First Call Community Notification System. No matching funds are required by this grant.
